Together, we provide Actuarial and Administrative Services for the plans. Our responsibilities include, but are not limited to, the completion of a bi-annual actuarial valuation reports, the completion of the Act 205 filings, the preparation of Minimum Municipal Obligations each year and general consulting services regarding pension related issues.

The third plan is a defined contribution plan. Don Boetger (Actuary) and Amy LaRocca (Retirement Plan Specialist) administer this plan for the requesting municipality. Together we provide administrative services for the Plan. Our responsibilities include, but are not limited to, the completion of annual record keeping reports, participant statements and distribution calculations.


