#### **EXPECT EMTA SERVICE DELAYS IN IMPENDING INCLEMENT WEATHER 12/23/22-12/26/22**

**ERIE, PENNSYLVANIA-** Due to predicted severe weather conditions, the EMTA advises passengers to expect delays in services beginning Friday, December 23, 2022 through the holiday weekend.

EMTA continues to monitor the weather and asks for riders' patience as many Fixed Route and LIFT services may run behind schedule due to the road conditions of the predicted winter storm. The EMTA advises riders to be cautious and dress very warm as they wait for the bus.
